Welcome

We look forward to having you join us for this year's *Adventure Music Camp*. We are delighted to have this opportunity to make music with you and hope the five days of camp will be fun and inspiring. The schedule will be given to you on the first day of camp.

Dates and Arrival

Adventure Music Camp meets Monday through Friday, August 1-5 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. each day. Students should enter the building at 26 Gibbs Street (Kilbourn Hall entrance) and meet in the main hall. They will receive information and name badges from Summer representatives at a table in the main hall past the Security checkpoint, if they have not already obtained them at orientation.

Classes

Each student will be placed in a group based on instrument and level. The groups will be divided into Strings and two bands (Winds/Brass/Percussion) for the first half of the day, and the groups will stay consistent for afternoon electives. Throughout the day, students will have hour-long sessions rehearsing with ensembles, learning various world music, percussion, and movement. The first set of classes run from about 9:15am-12:10pm, and the second set from 12:50pm-3:40pm. There is a lunch break in between which will be hosted at the Student Living Center courtyard. All students start the day together for morning meeting and close the day together before dismissal. Camp counselors will escort students between classes and buildings.

Pick-up

At 4 p.m. students will be dismissed to wait in a supervised area at the entrance to 26 Gibbs Street for pick-up by parents. Students are asked to remain there until the parent's car is in sight on Gibbs Street. Parents are always welcome to park and walk to the entrance of Eastman to pick up their child. Students should be picked up no later than 4:15 p.m.

What to Bring Every Day

Everyone is expected to bring their music, instruments, and a pencil, as well as supplies such as rosin, rock stop, reeds, ligatures, neck straps, mallets, drum sticks, and valve oil. *Percussionists will not need to bring their own instruments*. Students will also need to bring a mask (or two) and bell covers for their instruments each day. There will be a storage room available to lock instruments at the end of each day. Students should **bring their own lunch** – refrigeration is not provided.

Cell Phones

All cell phones will be collected prior to class and will be returned at the end of each day.

Dress Code

Attire is casual. Public school dress code rules apply. <u>Concert Attire</u>: All students should plan to wear pants or a skirt and the camp t-shirt (given out during the week) for the concert.

ID Cards

Summer name tags on lanyards will be distributed to each student that they must wear each day of the program.

Parking

Parking is available at the East End Garage behind Eastman School of Music. Limited parallel parking is available on Gibbs Street; payment may be made with cash or credit card at a pay station for on-street parking. There is no free parking downtown during camp hours.

Final Concert

The *Adventure Music Camp* culminates in a concert that will be open to families and friends of students. The concert will be Friday, Aug 5 at 3:30 p.m. in Kilbourn Hall. The concert will be less than an hour long. Cameras and phones may be used to take pictures or videos during the performance as long as there is no flash nor any recording lights. This year, our concert will be recorded and live streamed. We will share the recording with families. If you have family and friends who would like to watch the performance in the real time, they can view it by visiting https://www.esm.rochester.edu/live/kilbourn/.

Recording

Eastman will livestream and make video recordings of the concert, and they will be available for download several weeks following the performances.

Directions to Eastman School of Music

The Eastman School of Music is located in downtown Rochester, New York, about 20 minutes from the NYS Thruway (Interstate 90) and about 15 minutes from the Rochester International Airport.

By car from the west - Take route 90 to Exit 47, then Interstate 490 East to Rochester. As you approach downtown, follow the Inner Loop ramp to the left. Exit at Scio Street, and turn right. Proceed to the third light just past the East End Parking Garage. Turn right on East Avenue and then at the 2nd right, turn right again onto Gibbs Street. The Community Music School is immediately on the right at 10 Gibbs Street. The Sibley Music Library is on the left on the 2nd, 3rd and 4th floors. The Eastman School of Music is at 26 Gibbs Street. The Eastman Theatre is on the corner of Gibbs & Main. The Student Living Center is across Main Street at 100 Gibbs Street.

By car from the east - Take route 90 to Exit 45, then Interstate 490 West. Exit at Clinton Avenue (Exit 16). At the first light, turn right onto Woodbury Blvd. At the next light, turn left on Chestnut Street. Stay on Chestnut Street (about 200 yards) to East Avenue. Turn right on East Avenue, then immediately left on Gibbs Street. The Community Music School is immediately on the right at 10 Gibbs Street. The Sibley Music Library is on the left on the 2nd, 3rd and 4th floors. The Eastman School of Music is at 26 Gibbs Street. The Eastman Theatre is on the corner of Gibbs & Main. The Student Living Center is across Main Street at 100 Gibbs Street.

Payment

Full payment for the program is due upon receipt of payment instructions from the Summer Manager. Students with unpaid balances by the first day of the program may not participate.
